



# **SYNOPSIS**

A woman (Molly) who has just experienced a traumatic incident is unnerved by a haunting knocking sound from upstairs in her new apartment building. As the noises become more desperate and increasingly sound like cries for help, she confronts her neighbors, but it seems no one else can hear them. In an unsettling quest for truth, Molly soon realizes that no one believes her, and begins to question if she even believes herself – a realization that is perhaps even more chilling.

In her first narrative feature, director Frida Kempff crafts a sophisticated and psychologically suspenseful narrative in which she deftly amplifies Molly's gut-wrenching feelings of self-doubt, coupled with a fierce and soul-baring lead performance by actress Cecilia Milocco.

### **DIRECTORS STATEMENT**

KNOCKING is based on the short novel Knockings by Swedish genre author Johan Theorin.

When I first read the book, the me-too movement had just started and as a woman I could strongly connect with the stories coming from all over the world. The novel resembled our society today, how women are treated and how easy it is to judge a woman just by looks and appearance.

I immediately connected with the main character Molly who is being faced with distrust and prejudice from the neighbors and from the society. an untrustworthy citizen because of her background and how she acts. She is convinced that something is wrong and that she has witness something terrible, but what can be scarier then realize that no one believes you and that you start to Molly is marked as question yourself. Am I crazy?

Knocking is a film about a person that is being marginalized and isn't served the same rights and possibilities as everyone else in the society because of who she is.

In terms of the genre, I wanted to do something different from what the audience is used to. We are constantly overflowed with bodies of women that are stabbed, cut, naked in blood, hanged. It was important for me to not exploit in the female victim's body. I found it more interesting to focus on the witness and by doing that also engage the audience to be in Molly's perspective. It makes it scarier to question the events. When do we interfere in others private lives? What proofs do we need?

In Sweden there is a culture of mind your own business and Knocking is a film about the opposite to that - civil courage. Sometimes you need to raise your voice if something is really wrong because if we lose that I think that we are totally lost.

Knocking is a shout out to people that everyone has the right to be listen to.



# CECILIA MILOCCO, ACTRESS

Cecilia Milocco (1972) is a Swedish actress, choreographer and dancer. She is most known for *The Involuntary* (Cannes Film Festival - Uncertain regard), *Who Talks* (Cannes Film Festival - short film competition), *Shadow Animals* (Canal + Award, Clermont Ferrand).

Knocking is Cecilia and the director Frida Kempff second collaboration after the short film Dear Kid (2016).

FRIDA KEMPFF, DIRECTOR

Frida (1977) is a Swedish director and scriptwriter with a bachelor's degree from Stockholm Academy of Dramatic Arts. Her films have been screened and awarded at the main festivals, including Cannes, Sundance, Telluride, IDFA, London IFF and Gothenburg, and in 2010 she was the first Swede since 1957 to win an award with a short film at the main competition at Cannes with Bathing Micky. Knocking is Kempff's debut narrative feature film.



EMMA BROSTRÖM, SCRIPTWRITER

Emma Broström (born 1980) is a scriptwriter and playwright who studied at Teaterhögskolan in Malmö and at IHTV in Gothenburg, as well as Filmhögskolan in Gothenburg and StDH. She debuted as a scriptwriter with the highly acclaimed and awarded film Flocken, directed by Beata Gårdeler. The film won the Crystal Bear at the Berlin Film Festival 2015. It also won three Guldbaggar, the World Fiction Award at the Los Angeles Film Festival 2015, Best Script Olympia FF Athens Greece 2015, and Best Script at the Zimbabwe Film Festival 2015.



## ERIK ANDERSSON, PRODUCER/EDITOR

Erik Andersson (1982) is a Swedish producer. He has produced films for cinema, TV, and festivals, and holds a bachelor's degree in film editing. He has participated in international producers' workshops such as Rotterdam Lab, ACE, Young Nordic Producers Club in Cannes, Berlinale Talent, and Nordic Talents. His productions include short film Bathing Micky (Prix du Jury, Cannes, 2010), and features Knocking (Sundance Film Festival 2021) and Dogborn (in production).



## HANNES KRANTZ, CINEMATOGRAPHER

Hannes (1989) is a Swedish cinematographer. Hannes is a part of the Norrköping based collective Crazy Pictures. Starting off in 2009 the collective made several short films which many was huge hits on YouTube. In 2018 Hannes and Crazy pictures achieved international acclaim with their low-budget feature debut *The Unthinkable* which was sold to more than 100 countries and was a great hit on Swedish cinema.

## MARTIN DIRKOV, COMPOSER

Martin Dirkov is a Danish filmcomposer, sounddesigner and musician. He graduated from the Danish filmschool in 2011. Martin has composed music for several documentaries and feature films including *Shorta* by Anders Ølholm, Frederik Louis Hviid, *Gräns (Border)* by Ali Abassi, *Holiday* by Isabella Eklöf, *The Charmer* by Milad Alami and *Shelley* by Ali Abassi.

## ERIKA GONZALES, EDITOR

Erika Gonzales (1976) is a Sweden/London based film editor. Several films Erika has edited have won awards and achieved nominations in the festival circuit. Latest award-winning films she has worked on include, Josefine & Florin – Winner Best Editing at Guldbaggen 2020, Winter Buoy - Winner Best Documentary at Nordic International Film Festival NY 2015, Your childhood will never die - Winner Kulturnyheternas Bagge Award for best newcomer 2014.

### THOMAS JÆGER SOUND DESIGN

Thomas (1976) has a background as a film sound engineer from the Danish Film School. He has in recent years worked on major feature films and TV series including several Lars von Trier productions, Thomas Vinterberg and Christian Dyekjær. He engages in films and directors where there is an interest to discuss the approach, process and content of movie soundtrack, and he always maintains that the story is more important than sound's own expression.
